

Welcome to your school!

We provide courses in Swedish as a second language from the beginning level up to basic level: SFI 2 (course B and C), SFI 3 (course C and D) and SAS (*Svenska som andraspråk, grund*). You can study full time, part time, evening classes or distance courses.

If you prefer to study SFI daytime, you study four days a week and your schedule is based on 15h/week. If you prefer to study part time, distance or evenings it is possible to adjust the time to get the maximum hours per week that you are allowed to. This could make it possible for you to combine work and study.

Full time students: We appreciate if you plan for full time studies, including home assignments, since you are not in class the entire day.

Part time students: For a number of different reasons, this can be the best way for you to study Swedish. We offer part time studies on all levels mentioned above. Plan for home assignments between classes!

Evening classes: You have classes from 17:00 – 20:00, two evenings per week, Mondays and Wednesdays or Tuesdays and Thursdays. Plan for home assignments between classes!

Distance students: To study a second language on distance is probably an option for students who already has a good knowledge of Swedish and aims at certain aspects of knowledge, such as writing better texts or improve vocabulary and reading skills. Please let us know what you need to improve and we will work out an individual solution together.

If you want to study SAS, which is the basic level, you study 20h/week. A completed course makes you ready for most work situations and, furthermore, gives you the right to apply for the course *Swedish as a second language* at the upper secondary level. (Most students need the upper secondary level in Swedish, in order to apply for university studies).

On all levels your schedule contains the following aspects of the language: Swedish, conversation, grammar, literature, media, interactive language learning programs, writing, listening- and pronunciation exercises.

When you study at our school we offer you two extra courses: *Introduction to Office programs and Internet* and *Introduction to the Swedish driver license test* (theory). If you find this interesting you can fill in your application here at school, when you start your SFI or SAS course.

It is highly recommended that you join, or form, a smaller study group while studying at our school. You have access to computers, course materials and a place to focus on your work. Your results will improve as you work together, your understanding of Swedish will grow and you will probably have great fun as well!

We have qualified and experienced teachers who will help you succeed in your studies. All teachers studied courses in second language acquisition and most of them have spent longer periods of time abroad. Their qualifications and their long experience from adult education forms your supporting structure when you take on the hard work to study Swedish as a second language!

However, to truly succeed in second language acquisition you have to understand your own responsibility, and perhaps the most important: your own motivation! To get motivated enough you need to carefully formulate your goals! Talk to people, define your strengths, seek advice from different people and investigate your options!
